Isolated Adrenal Metastases are cancers that spread from other parts of the body (the breast, lung, or skin) to the adrenal gland. Systemic treatment with chemotherapy is usually recommended for this kind of metastatic cancer, but if the adrenal gland is the only spread site (isolated adrenal metastases), then surgical removal with laparoscopic adrenalectomy is usually an option.

### Adrenal gland: Function, hormones, and disorders

Adrenal disorders (cortex and medulla) The adrenal gland is divided into twodistinct areas, the cortex and the medulla. The cortex is further divided in 3 zones (zona glomerulosa or site of aldosterone synthesis, zona fasciculata or site of cortisol synthesis and zona reticularis or site of androgen synthesis).

### Adrenal disorders (cortex and medulla)

This rare disorder develops when the adrenal glands do not make enough cortisol. In most cases of Addison's disease, the body also doesn't make enough of the hormone aldosterone. Addison's is an autoimmune disease—a condition in which the immune system, which is supposed to protect the body, mistakenly attacks the body's own tissues and cells.
