How to Reference Books and Articles in Text Before computers, we used typewriters to underline book titles, and we placed quotation marks around article titles. However, many current style manuals recommend italicizing book titles and magazine names (impossible to do on a typewriter) and using quotation marks around articles.

The basic format for an in-text citation is: Title of the Book (Author Last Name, year). Examples One author: Where the Wild Things Are (Sendak, 1963) is a depiction of a child coping with his anger towards his mom.

How do I refer to a book by title in-text in APA format ...

Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location.

The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, and publisher. For example: Rogers, C. R. (1961).

The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

Citations of books in your Reference List should begin with the last name of the book's author, then the author's initials. Next, write the year of publication within parentheses. After the year, list the title of the book in sentence case -- only capitalize the first word of the title and subtitle, if applicable, just as if you were writing a sentence.

Is a Book Title Underlined or Italicized When Typing In ...

Reference book titles outside of parentheses. For example, write "In the novel Being in Love, Smith has defined love as a social impulse." According to APA format, italicize the book title (here "Being in Love"). Write the name of the author in parentheses, along with the year a work was published and the page number you are referencing.

According to the Chicago Manual of Style and the Modern Language Association, titles of books (and other complete works, such as newspapers and magazines), should be italicized. So if abiding by either of those guides, you'd italicize Stephen King's The Shining , just as you would Vanity Fair and The Miami Herald (and Appetite for Destruction , if your protagonist is a Guns N' Roses fan).

Do You Underline Book Titles? Italicize? Put inside Quote ...

Note: When you list the pages of the chapter or essay in parentheses after the book title, use "pp." before the numbers: (pp. 1-21). This abbreviation, however, does not appear before the page numbers in periodical references. List any edition number in the same set of parentheses as the page numbers, separated by a comma: (2nd ed., pp. 66-72).

If the book you're citing is a second or later edition (i.e. when the edition is stated on the title page or cover), specify this in your reference. Abbreviate 'edition' to 'edn' or 'revised edition' to 'rev ed'. When referencing a book published in multiple volumes, include the total number of volumes in your reference.

If the author of the book does not appear in the title of the book, include the name, with a "By" after the title of the book and before the publisher. Note that this type of citation is less common and should only be used for papers or writing in which translation plays a central role.

Format titles referred to in your text correctly. When you cite a book in APA, you type the title in sentence-case in your reference list. However, if you name the title in your actual paper, use title case, capitalizing all words that are longer than 4 letters. Put quotation marks around shorter works, such as chapters or articles.

Other style guides allow using double quotation marks for the title of the books. For example, "The House of the Seven Gables" by Nathaniel Hawthorne, "The Stranger" by Albert Camus, "The Great Gatsby" by Francis Scott Fitzgerald, etc. In this case, we do not use italics anymore.

Write The Title of a Book in an Essay Properly

The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the end, provided it directly takes you to the full text without logging in.

Both APA book in-text citation rules and rules for reference list entries state that the title should be in sentence case. This means that every word in the title should be lowercase, with the following exceptions: Proper nouns, such as peoples' names The first word in the title

Add the title of the book in italics. Type the title of the book in title case, capitalizing only the first word, nouns, pronouns, verbs, and adverbs. If the book has a subtitle, place a colon at the end of the title to introduce the subtitle. Type the title of the subtitle in title case.

General Tips Capitalization: Book title and chapter title are in sentence case - Only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized. Always capitalize the first word, the first word after a colon or a dash.
