The apostle Paul made an urgent plea to his Christian audience: a) to present their bodies as a living sacrifice to God (v. 1 - 2), b) to serve one another in the Church body (v. 3 - 8), and c) to actively love people without hypocrisy (v. 9 - 21).

Verse 9 has no logical connection to what precedes. Then in verses 9-21 Paul discharges a series of rapid-fire exhortations that whiz by without much connection or clarification. But a closer look shows that the passage is not arbitrary, but loosely tied to what precedes it in 12:1-8.
